Key Responsibilities

- Fault-find and support repairs on HVAC components using diagnostic tools and guidance from senior staff.
- Record job details accurately, complete paperwork and update service reports and site documentation.
- Ensure safe working practices on site: risk assessments, method statements (RAMS), PPE and site induction compliance.
- Maintain tools, vehicle stock and basic site housekeeping. Report parts shortages and escalate technical issues.
- Support compliance with company policies and regulatory requirements (F-Gas, COSHH, etc.).
- Communicate professionally with clients and Spheretech teams; escalate client concerns to supervisors.

Essential Skills & Qualifications

- Basic HVAC qualification or working towards : City & Guilds, NVQ Level 2 or equivalent, or proven hands-on HVAC experience.
- Practical experience assisting with air conditioning installation/maintenance (commercial or light-commercial).
